Work Plan--FY 2018

To fulfill the reporting requirements of the FY 2018 School Based Health Center grant agreements, each Center must submit a quarterly progress report that illustrates the Center's success in meeting the measurable goals, objectives, and tasks outlined in this work plan.

Goal #1: Increase percentage of unduplicated SBHC clients who had at least <u>one comprehensive well-care visit</u> with a primary care practitioner or an OB/GYN practitioner during the school year, regardless of where exam was provided, including documentation of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Health and developmental history AND • Physical exam AND • Health education/anticipatory guidance 		
Objective # 1A: Identify, enroll and provide services to new and established clients for at least one comprehensive well-care visit provided by the SBHC during the school year.		
Tasks by Quarter	Expected Outcome(s)	How Outcome(s) Will Be Measured
Provide appropriate SBHC services to new and established clients who have been identified to be eligible for the Program.	Clients enrolled in the Program will receive appropriate SBHC services.	Encounter data will show the number of new and established clients screened.
Identify clients who are due for services and send rescreening reminders.	Clients will receive rescreening services according to established time frames.	Encounter data will show the number of established clients served.
Analyze first quarter caseload to assure 25% of FY 2018 projected caseload is achieved.	Attain 25% of the projected caseload. Evaluate outreach strategies if required caseload is not attained and readjust plan.	Encounter data will show the total number of clients served.

Provide unduplicated SBHC clients with documentation of ≥1 age-appropriate annual risk assessment during the school year.	Clients enrolled in SBHC will have ≥1 age-appropriate annual risk assessment during the school year.	Encounter data will show the number of age-appropriate annual risk assessment during the school year.

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Goal #3: Increase percentage of SBHC clients aged 3-20 years with <u>BMI >85th percentile</u> with documentation of the following at least once during the school year: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • BMI percentile AND • Counseling for nutrition AND • Counseling for physical activity 		
Objective # 3A: Identify, enroll and provide services to new clients with BMI >85 th percentile who had at least one visit of any type to the SBHC during the school year.		
Tasks by Quarter	Expected Outcome(s)	How Outcome(s) Will Be Measured
Provide unduplicated SBHC aged 3-20 years with a BMI >85 percentile with documentation of BMI, counseling for nutrition and physical activity.	Clients enrolled in SBHC with BMI >85 th percentile will have documentation of BMI, counseling for nutrition and physical activity.	On-site certification review
Goal #4: Increase percentage of unduplicated SBHC clients aged ≥12 years with documentation of the following at least once during the school year: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Screened for clinical depression</u> using an age appropriate standardized tool AND • Follow-up plan documented if positive screen 		
Objective # 4A: Identify, enroll and provide services to new clients ≥12 years who had at least one visit of any type to the SBHC during the school year.		
Tasks by Quarter	Expected Outcome(s)	How Outcome(s) Will Be Measured
Provide new clients aged ≥12 years screening for clinical depression using an age appropriate standardized tool.	New clients enrolled in SBHC aged ≥12 years will be screened for clinical depression.	Encounter data will show the number of age-appropriate annual risk assessment during the school year.

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Goal #5: Increase percentage of SBHC female and male clients identified as sexually active who had <u>≥1 test for Chlamydia</u> documented during the school year.		
Objective # 5A: Identify, enroll and provide services to new clients who identify as sexually active who had at least one visit of any type to the SBHC during the school year.		
Tasks by Quarter	Expected Outcome(s)	How Outcome(s) Will Be Measured
Provide annual Chlamydia testing for female or male clients who identify as sexually active.	Provide STD testing for sexually active clients enrolled in SBHC during the school year.	STD data will show the number of Chlamydia tests during the school year.
Goal #6: Increase <u>vaccination rates for prevention of human papillomaviruses</u>, also known as HPV, among unduplicated SBHC female and male clients ages 11 to 18 years during the school year.		
Objective # 6A: Identify, enroll and provide services to new clients ages 11 to 18 years who had at least one visit of any type to the SBHC during the school year.		
Tasks by Quarter	Expected Outcome(s)	How Outcome(s) Will Be Measured
Provide HPV vaccine to new female or male SBHC clients ages 11 to 18 years identified as <u>not</u> having had the HPV vaccine.	Vaccinate new clients enrolled in SBHC ages 11 to 18 years identified as <u>not</u> having had HPV vaccine.	IDPH Vaccination data will show the number of HPV vaccines given by school during the school year.
